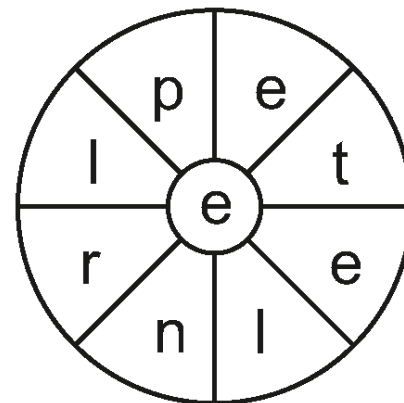

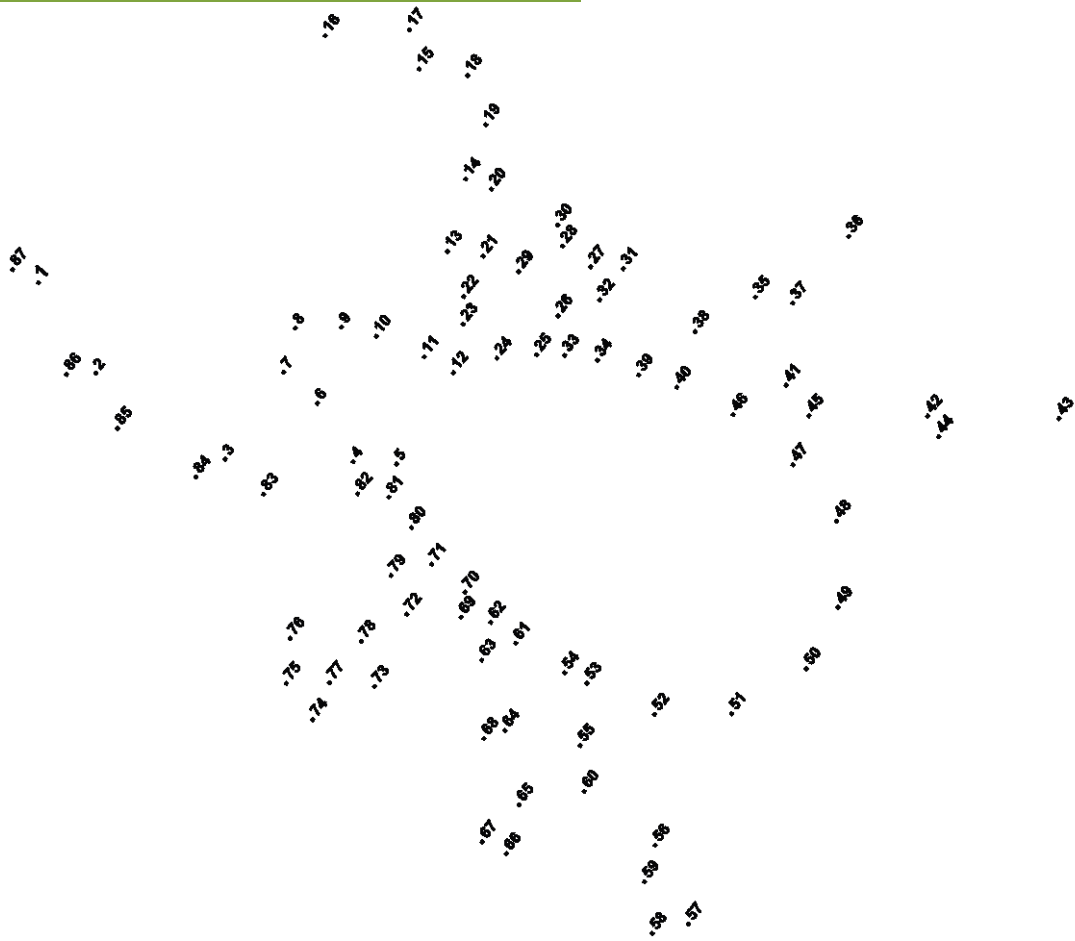
### Word Wheel

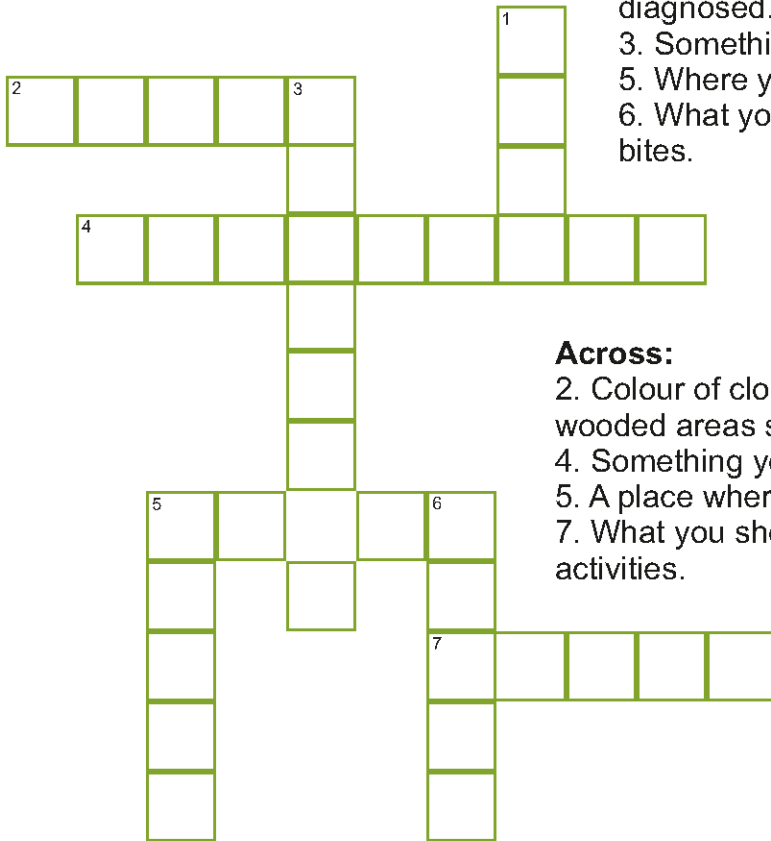

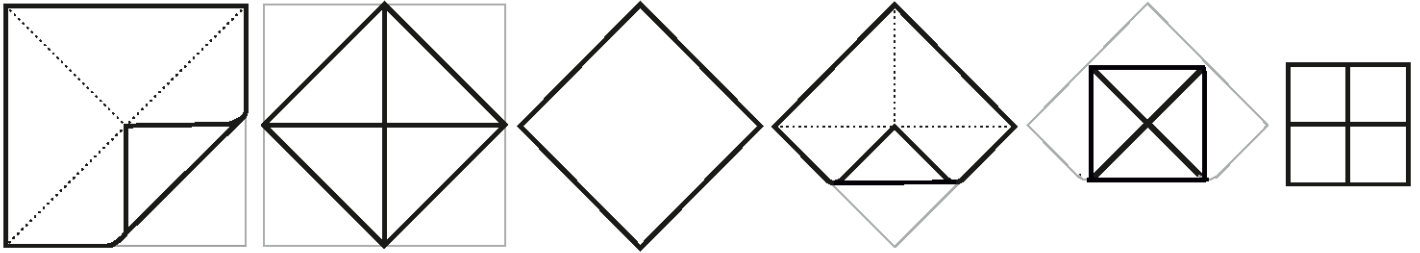
