Lyme disease is the fastest growing vector-borne disease in Northern Europe and is spread by the bite of an infected tick. Ticks are now endemic across the UK and as well as being found in woodland and heathland, they have also been found in urban parks and gardens. Lyme disease can be an insidious illness if not diagnosed and treated promptly.

Every May, Lyme Disease UK (registered charity no. 1182212) carries out a month-long 'Wake Up To Lyme' campaign to raise awareness of Lyme disease and how to prevent it. This year, LDUK hopes to reach many more people and to educate the public on how to prevent tick bites.
